Pastor Words of Wisdom

We have officially entered the Lenten season, which is a time where we are called to be intentional in preparing ourselves and our community for the death and resurrection of Jesus.

But what exactly does it mean to be intentional during this time? And why shouldn't we be intentional the rest of the year with our faith.

To answer the second question first - we should! We should always be intentional in how we nurture our faith and prepare ourselves to follow in the footsteps of Christ. But...we also know that life sometimes gets in the way.

Our lives can become busy, hectic, difficult, demanding, and everything in between. This can make it hard for us to always prioritize our faith and spiritual growth. That's okay! We are not perfect and can't always bring our "A" game to our spiritual journey.

And that is part of the reason we have Lent. It is an acknowledgement that we aren't always on our best behavior as Christians, but that we know that there are times where we have to at least try.

Which is where the intentional part comes in. For the 40 days of Lent, we are asked to prioritize our faith, be intentional in trying to connect with our spirituality, and work hard at preparing ourselves to more fully follow Jesus.

We are encouraged to fast from the things in our lives that distract us from our faith. We are challenged to create the space needed to connect with God. We are called to divest ourselves from the actions and thoughts that cause us to harm others.

And we are to do all of those things with focus and intention.

Now is the time to make up for the fact that we don't always stay on the path that God lays before us. Now is the time to repent, turn back toward God, and refocus ourselves on our faith.

If you haven't done a great job at some of those things in the last year, that's okay. You are human. We all are.

But ask yourself this - for the next 40 days, how can I be a better version of myself. How can I make an impact on the world? How can I grow closer to my God and my neighbor? All it takes is a little intentionality.
