Pastor Words of Wisdom

I always find Christian holidays to be interesting, because most people assume them to be the end points of certain seasons or times of the year, and then we move on to the next thing. Christmas marks the end of Advent and the "Happy Holidays" season. Easter marks the end of Lent and (hopefully) an end to winter.

Once they are done, we often ask ourselves, "what's next?"

But I always tend to view them as beginnings instead; as the days of the year when I am reminded of all of the things that I as a follower of Christ need to start (or restart) doing.

Let's take Easter for example, since it is the holiday we are about to celebrate. Easter does, officially, mark the end of Lent. But it also is the day that we are reminded that Jesus' time on earth has ended, and it is now up to us to spread the Gospel in his place.

Easter is our invitation to start spreading the Good News to the world. It is the beginning of our Great Commission!

Jesus has ascended to heaven, which leaves us as his followers to take over the work that he was doing. We are now the ones who have to offer hospitality, who have to welcome the stranger, who have to eat with the poor and pray with the sinner and love our neighbor.

The tomb is empty. Jesus is no longer here. It's up to us now!

Easter should not just be another waypoint throughout our year. It is not something that should happen and then be forgotten about until next year. It should be our reminder that we are called to do so much more. It should be the day that we fully embrace the idea that we are the hands and feet of God.

Easter is the day we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, and then understand what that resurrection means for us in our daily lives.

Jesus defeated death so that we could truly live. What will we make of this newfound life? What will we do to help others more fully live their lives?

What new beginnings can we embrace this Easter Sunday so that we can bring even more Good News to even more people?


ST. PAUL EARLY LEARNING CENTER
