Pastor Words of Wisdom

As we move into summer (finally!) and I plan my many outdoor adventures, I am reminded, as I always am, of the effortless beauty that surrounds us at all times. And I wonder whether or not we truly appreciate the gifts of nature; whether we truly appreciate the gift of creation that God bestows upon us.

It seems important to remind ourselves that nature was created before we were. God made the oceans and the forests and the mountains and the creatures before we ever graced the earth. We came second; nature came first.

I think a big reason for that is because nature highlights the depth of who God is, and creates a backdrop for our beliefs and our ability to have faith. Without it, I'm not sure we could have the faith we do.

Let me explain.

Our faith has the potential to be vibrant and colorful and deep. It is not a small, limited thing that restricts us and makes our life smaller. Faith expands our understanding of the world and adds a deepness to our lives.

And much of that depth comes from our experience of the world. When we look around and see the fullness of God's creation, we understand a little bit more of how deep and wide God is.

When we understand that, we allow our faith to become deep and wide as well. Because our faith reflects the God that we know and believe in. If we believe God is narrow and full of hate, then we too will be narrow and full of hate.

But when we see the vibrancy and beauty of creation, we know that creation is reflecting God. And it gives us the freedom to have a vibrant and beautiful faith. If we were surrounded by nothing but gray, dull concrete, our faith would suffer as a result. It would become gray and dull and boring.

Think about the times when you feel closest to God - do they occur when you are stuck inside an office building? When you are sitting in the waiting room of the BMV? When you're trapped in a poorly lit doctor's office?

Or do they occur when the sun is shining on your face? When you are sitting under the shade of a large tree? When you are hearing the waves crash onto the beach? Or seeing and smelling the flowers in full bloom?

In my opinion, nature and creation are requirements for our faith. We cannot know God without knowing all of the things that God created.

So this summer, take time to appreciate the beauty around you. Allow it to deepen your faith and increase your understanding of who God is. I promise you won't regret it.

PARISH NURSES


