Pastor Words of Wisdom

As hard as it is to believe, summer is almost over and fall is well on its way - even if the temperatures are still in the 90s.

And with fall comes an inevitable but necessary time of change. We will soon switch from air conditioning to heat. We will go from shorts and shirts to pants and jackets. All of the green around us will slowly go away and the days will get shorter.

Change can be hard. I don't know many people who get excited that summer eventually turns into winter, or that the sun will start going down closer to 5pm instead of 10pm, or that flowers will no longer be blooming.

But change also brings new opportunities. Fall means football season (go Michigan State Spartans!), orange and yellow and red leaves, pumpkin patches, apple cider, a cool breeze, and much less sweat.

When summer ends, it brings the space and opportunity for something else good to come. The same is true of our lives.

We struggle to deal with change as human beings. We are naturally inclined to want stability and equilibrium. That's what feels safe to us.

But staying in the same exact place can also be dangerous. If we allow our lives to become stagnant, that means we are no longer growing and exploring and experiencing - all things that God wants for us.

Change is a central part of our faith because true faith demands that we both make ourselves better and follow God, and God often leads us to new places and new lives. If we are completely committed to staying in the same place then we will miss out on all of the exciting and life-changing things that God is calling us to.

Just as being in summer the entire year would not be a good thing in the long run (much of nature is designed to rest and recharge in the winter - just like us!), being in the exact same place we are now for the rest of our lives would be a tragedy.

It would mean we haven't grown or become better versions of ourselves or listened to the various ways that God is calling us forward.

So does change sometimes feel scary and annoying and overwhelming. Yes, of course! But never changing feels even scarier to me. We were created to grow and to experience life and to follow in the footsteps of God.

Kind of hard to do if we never move, don't you think?

- Sharing of previous meeting minutes were read
- Minutes accepted as presented.

Team/Committee Reports

Building (Skip)

- Keys: We have a key list all accounted.
- Waiting to hear back from parking lot light repair.
- Still following up with Hill Top Electric to replace bathroom exhaust fans, kitchen hood fan and motor replaced.
- Trees and Bushes work in front of church completed. Still other tree work to be done.

Finance (Mike I)

- Shared budget numbers (need to verify)
 - Journey Checking Balance: \$23,872.52
 - Journey Savings: \$788,289.30
 - St. Paul Savings: \$49,951.32
 - -St. Paul Endowment: \$133,115.47
- Giving Totals first 5 months: \$77,122.93
- Need to get with Anne on Church Trac to do a more detailed breakdown of revenue
- Met with Johnson investments (Joe Carlos) to discuss investment opportunities- Were Impressed.
- One more investment firm to meet with within a couple weeks.
- Ultimately we will likely work with two investment groups.
- P&G shares paperwork in progress and will be finished soon.
- Have gotten with Griffin Fletcher Herndon firm to work on waterworks exempt transfer to journey community church.

Personnel (Ben)

- Have been in contact with George and continue to need to find musician substitutes
- Continuing to work through and update job descriptions.
- Musician/Music Director search continues.
- Was recommended that we have additional variety to our Sunday worship music experience.

Spiritual (Robin)

- Vickie's group met with Brian about visiting and how to best engage with our shut-ins. There are 8 volunteering for this.
- Spoke with Trudy about having music during service during communion, offering, etc.
- Pastor Washington is having his choir join and support music needs on the Sunday he preaches.
- Robin got quilt to Jaliah Williams, the young girl in our community who was hurt.
- Working actively on VBS.
- Missy working on church attending city local events.

Pastoral (Brian)

- Will lead funeral for Don Fisher this week.
- Preparing for to lead story at VBS and actively pushing out our VBS to the community via Facebook
- Working on getting T-shirts mocked up
- Received Best Buy quote for media upgrades. \$30k. This includes additional hook up of monitor in Sunday School Room, internet, among other items.
- Board agreed to increase original budget by \$4k. Motion passed 5-0.
- Mike continues to be point person on this project.

Board Chair (Steve)

- Zwoster Committee Recommendations. There was discussion concerning membership criteria to meet membership eligibility. There were 3 applicants.
- Motion passed for Dillon 5-0 who actively participated in church approved
- Motion passed for Mandy 4-1
- Motion passed for Madison 4-0-1
- Agreed that Steve would produce a letter articulating rational and perspective on the approval to be sent out to recipients and recommendations for future scholarship criteria.
- Provided additional updates regarding the learning center grant monies to be used to improve facilities. Shared tile recommendations for floor to also be used at sanctuary Church entrance.
- Galbraith condos requested use of our café meeting space on Tuesdays. Board supported this as a form of community outreach.
- Fence update agreed on.
- Board agreed to suspend next board meeting in meet next in August.
