


Here is a look into our income sources for the year from January to the end of October:

BEING GOOD STEWARDS

We have a responsibility to make sure that we are successful and able to survive even 5, 10, or 20 years from now. Many of us might no longer be here then, but we want the legacy of this church and community to thrive long after we are gone.

As a result of this belief, we have been intentional in being good stewards of our finances so that future members of Journey Community Church have the resources needed to continue our mission and vision.

This year we invested \$300,000 with Edward Jones and expanded our investments with Johnson Investments by increasing its funds to \$300,000 as well. We also transferred ownership of \$81,000 in P&G stock to Journey Community Church, and will receive continued dividend payments on those.

These investments provide a solid foundation for our church moving forward, and our plan is to allow the principal amounts to go untouched for as long as possible.

As you may have noticed, we as a church are running at a budget deficit - spending more than we are bringing in. Overall this isn't an issue, especially in the first year of a new church. We have been working hard to improve our building, add programs, and create a more modern and welcoming environment.

Taking a long-term view means, however, that we need to have a more balanced budget moving forward. There are things we can do around the margins to tighten things up, but we need to spend money in order to grow our church.

That means the most important thing we need moving forward is continued - and increased - giving from each and every one of you. We as a church are nothing without you, and we cannot succeed and survive without the generosity that you provide us each week.

The encouragement form this annual report is that we are doing amazing things and they are only possible because of you. The challenge is that if we want to grow - our church, our faith, and our impact - it means we need more resources in order to live out our abundance mindset. Either way, I am extremely proud of this congregation and eternally grateful for all of the ways that you bless this community and one another. I wouldn't want to be doing church with anyone else!
