

January 8th, 2024 Board Meeting Notes

Steve opened meeting with and Brian prayed at 6:05pm. Five board members and pastor were present.

• Sharing of previous meeting minutes were read and accepted as presented.

Team/Committee Reports

Finance (Mike I) Shared budget numbers (need to plug in new numbers to get from Treasurer)

Journey Checking Balance: \$27,961.92

Journey Savings: \$377,555.54

SPELC Grant Money: \$104,505.96

St. Paul Checking: \$19,273.01

Schwab JCC: \$138,426.03

• Edward Jones: \$385,795.45 (now includes P & G Stock)

Edward Jones (cash account): \$1296.79

- Finance team to meet with Schwab later in January do to consultant illness.
- SPELC received another grant of \$37,770.00
- 2024 Proposed Budget changes and updates shared and discussed with Board
 - ♦ Board voted and agreed to proceed with final budget updates and to have the document shared in advance of January (previously our December) congregational meeting.

Building (Skip)

- Reported that the Rooftop units for fellowship hall and water heater in boiler room are installed and functioning.
- Sanctuary laptop computer- Mike B. to make recommendation.

Personnel (Ben)

- Team has created employee assessment forms to gain feedback for our staff: Senior Minister, Office Administrator/ Treasurer, and Sexton. To be made available at congregational meeting.
- Working to finalize Office Administrator and Treasurer contract and job descriptions ready to share. Met with Brian
 and Steve to gain their inputs.
- Beginning to work on employee assessments.

Spiritual (Robin)

- Shared progress on gaining clarity between Teams and Sub Teams and shared list with responsibilities to Board.
- Reviewed the time and talents that were submitted by congregation and handed out a breakdown of the volunteer opportunities for spiritual groups.

Spiritual (Robin) (continued)

- Shared discussion of possible future monthly events.
- Announced the start of Pairs and Spares fellowship dinners.
- The activities room has been cleaned out and is being painted. New blinds need to be purchased.

Pastoral (Brian)

- Preparation for Lent, including Ash Wednesday is underway.
- Working on worship experience and presentation consistency.
- Live Streaming progress reported to be getting closer to happening. This includes getting side cameras to function properly.

Additional Business (Steve)

- January 21st Annual Congregational Mtg agenda reviewed and aligned.
- Agreed to proposed Zwoster Memorial Scholarship update specifics regarding eligibility and financial considerations as presented.


INFORMATION NEEDED FOR THOSE ON PRAYER LIST
