Pastor Words of Wisdom

We as humans love to live in the binary. We want things to be simple and straightforward. There is good and there is evil. There is black and there is white. There is this and that, us and them, one or the other.

But the world is not that simple, and neither is our God. There is so much more than the extreme ends of the spectrum, and it's the in-between that gives us the beauty of the world.

When looking at the creation story in Genesis, we often view it as a binary creation of the world. God created light and darkness. God created day and night, separated the waters above from the waters below; created creatures of the land, and sky, and sea.

Each and every thing separated and in its own place. Except, that's not the whole story.

There may be day and night, but there is plenty in between as well. There are cloudy, dark days. There are bright, star-lit nights. There is the warm welcome of a sunrise that blurs the edges of when night becomes day, and the stunning beauty of a sunset that keeps us between two worlds.

God separated the waters above from the waters below. But there is rain. There are puddles that dot the ground. Waterfalls that cut through the sky, mist that clings to the air, and islands in the middle of the ocean.

God may have created one and then the other, but then He filled the space in between with all sorts of wonders and goodness. There might be black and white, but there are also a hundred shades of gray.

And it's in that gray that we mostly live. And it's in that gray that we find beauty.

We as people are filled with gray! We are living embodiments of the in-between. We are so rarely completely one thing and not another. We are a beautiful, messy, complicated, and unique set of experiences, feelings, and identities.

Which means we should stop viewing the world any differently than ourselves. We should stop separating this group from that. We should stop assuming that this thing or person is all evil, while the other thing or person is all good.

The world is not black and white, and that's a good thing! The world is all sorts of gray, and so are we. The end-points of a line might be 1 and 1,000, but that means there are 998 other numbers in-between.

Besides, God is often found in the in-between spaces.


