I was on a walk a few days ago, trying to meet my steps goal for the day.

It was a bright, sunny day and it seemed like the perfect time to get outside for a bit. For the most part, I was right. Until about halfway through my walk when a dark cloud suddenly passed overhead and a downpour began that lasted only a few minutes.

Those few minutes were enough to soak me to the bone. I then had to finish the second half of my walk in wet clothes and squishy shoes. I was annoyed and frustrated at first.

But as I walked, I saw water glistening on the grass, on the ground, and the leaves of nearby trees. I saw flowers in full bloom, coming back alive as the sun peaked around the clouds.

Which made me realize that while I didn't particularly enjoy being wet, I do overall enjoy rain. It's something that is necessary to make the world as beautiful as it is. Without it there would be no lilies or daisies or giant oak trees for us to enjoy. Rain is a requirement for things to grow.


