## Pastor Words of Wisdom

We are fully in the midst of the holiday season.

Thanksgiving, Advent, Christmas, New Year's. We have things to plan, events to attend, gifts to buy, and people to see. It is a nonstop month of sometimes overwhelming busyness.

It can be difficult for us to slow down and appreciate all that is around us - things, people, and places that we should be grateful for.

Because gratitude is something we should experience more often, especially during this time of year. There is a lot to be thankful for!

But gratitude is not something that will just magically happen. It is something that we would do well to practice, because we can absolutely become better at being grateful.

Studies have shown that the more we outwardly express gratitude - telling people that we are thankful for them, vocally appreciating what they do for us, returning the favor of kindness - the more we will actually *feel* grateful.

And when we do this, not only does it increase our positive feelings, it will also uplift the person we are actively grateful for. It's a win-win scenario.
