Pastor Words of Wisdom

Football season is officially upon us, which means it's time to pull out the jerseys, order the pizza and wings, and get ready for another mediocre Bengals season (just kidding!).

It also means it's time for me to break out one of my favorite sayings from when I was a coach - do your 1/11th.

This was a phrase I repeated to my players over and over. It was a reminder that we were a team; that everyone had their specific role, and for us to be successful, each person had to do their role and only their role.

Football is a sport that relies on each person doing one specific thing, and if all 11 players on the field do their thing, the play will be a success. But if you worry about what everyone else is doing, or try to do their job for them, or don't trust the player next to you, then your team will fail.

A team with 11 quarterbacks would never win a game. The same with 11 lineman. A team with a wide receiver trying to be a running back, or a tight end trying to be a quarterback, would also continue to lose.

Each role is important and each person must stay within their role.

The same could be said of a church. We each have our own skillset, or own strengths, and our own roles. If we all tried to be the pastor, or all tried to lead the same event, or all volunteered to do the exact same thing, we wouldn't get anything done.

A football team's diversity in skill is its greatest strength. Our church's diversity is our greatest strength too.
